



## ASSIGNMENT - GOVERNMENT LIFE INSURANCE BENEFITS

NATIONAL SERVICE LIFE INSURANCE - An assignment may be made only in favor of the insured's widow, widower, child, father, mother, grandfather, grandmother, brother or sister.

UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT LIFE INSURANCE - An assignment may be made only in favor of the insured's widow, widower, child, grandchild, parent, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, nephew, niece, brother-in-law, or sister-in-law.
